STREAMIN3 FUN IN CLASSROOMS!

DECEMBER 2021

The STREAMin3 Curriculum is an integrated, intentional, interactions Curriculum developed at the UVA's Center for Advanced Study of Teaching and Learning (CASTL). The STREAMin3 Curriculum provides a structure for teachers to support children's development and learning through daily activities and games that maximize the moment-to-moment interactions between children and their teachers and peers. This curriculum focuses on 5 core skills that form the building blocks for learning; relate, regulate, think, communicate, and move! Children learn to relate with peers and adults while learning to regulate their emotions, attention and behavior. The curriculum also encourages communication with others productively while teaching children how to move their bodies to achieve goals. The STREAMin3 Curriculum also incorporates 6 STREAM Skills: Science, Technology, Reading, Engineering, Art, and Math. These STREAM Skills help prepare children for success in Kindergarten and beyond. The Obici Healthcare Foundation has provided the funding for The Children's Center to implement STREAMin3 in 5 of our classrooms. We are in our third year as a pilot program implementing STREAMin3.
