On February 29, 2024, Ms. Angela Gary was honored at Camp Community College as a Local Living Legend for Black History Month. Ms. Angela's recognition reads as follows:

Angela Gary, a native of Southampton County, is nearing the completion of a 40-year tenure at the Children's Center. Angela currently serves as a Lead Early Head Start Teacher and has taught and influenced hundreds of children and families in the Western Tidewater Community. "I've had the opportunity to work with families, service coordinators, social services, and many other community services professionals," she said. Ms. Gary has a special place in her heart for special needs children. "When I first decided to work in Early Intervention, I really felt like special needs children were not getting the attention they needed. After being with the Children's Center program, I saw that no child was left behind or left out. I've watched the children grow, learn, and pass their educational goals, one child at a time," she said. She has also served as a Safe Group Sitter Class Teacher, Rural Infant Care Project Instructor (Franklin and Southampton County), Danny Chitwic Project teacher, Southampton Extension Service Technician, and Parent Group Instructor. She is a graduate of Camp Community College!
